### NAS PATUXENT RIVER INSTRUCTION 5090.5A

Subj: REGULATED WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN IMPLEMENTATION ORDER

1. Purpose. The Public Works Department's Environmental Division is directed by the Commanding Officer, Naval Air Station (NAS) Patuxent River, to oversee and provide necessary guidance associated with the generation, accumulation, analysis, transportation, recordkeeping, storage, and disposal of regulated waste resulting from operations performed at NAS Patuxent River Complex (PRC). A key factor in minimizing the generation of regulated waste includes the proper management and use of hazardous materials. This instruction provides guidance to satisfy the requirements associated with the cradle to grave management of hazardous materials while minimizing the risks associated with and the amount of waste being generated and classified as "Hazardous Waste" in accordance with reference (a).

2. Cancellation. NASPAXRIVINST 5090.5

3. Background. Reference (a) directs the PRC to develop and implement a Hazardous Waste Management Plan providing site-specific guidance to ensure compliance with the governing regulations. Reference (a) also identifies to the PRC the requirements and responsibilities for the control and management of hazardous materials. References (b) and (c) are the established governing regulations for the proper management and control of waste that is classified as "hazardous waste." The NAS PRC Installation Commanding Officer has determined that missions will operate in a manner compatible with the environment while reducing the risk to personnel associated with the use and storage of hazardous material (HM) and minimizing

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the amount of HM being sent for disposal. Reference (d) is the Regulated Waste Management Plan (RWMP) for the PRC. The RWMP is written to comply with all regulations governing the generation, accumulation, storage, and proper disposal of all regulated waste. During the performance of operational mission requirements within the PRC a variety of waste is generated. Not all wastes generated are classified as "hazardous waste." Reference (d), when properly implemented, ensures that proper identification is performed in order to determine how to properly manage and dispose of every identified waste.

4. Action. Commanding Officers, NAS Patuxent River Department Heads, Competency Managers, Officers-in-Charge, Tenant Activities, and contractors operating at the NAS Patuxent River Complex shall implement and comply with reference (d). Per reference (e), reference (d) is identified as a controlled document and is accessible via EMSweb.
