Family SGLI (FSGLI) provides life insurance coverage for Dependent SPOUSE and children of all Service members (Active Duty, Ready Reserve, and National Guard who have full-time SGLI coverage)

COMMAND:

- 1. Is REQUIRED to submit a Personal Casualty Report (PCR) via the DEFENSE CASUALTY INFORMATION PROCESSING SYSTEM (DCIPS).
- 2. <u>MILPERSMAN 1770-030 (navy.mil)</u> states in part: Dependent Death. The timely reporting of a dependent death will facilitate follow-on actions. 3.

REPORTING:

1. Web-based Personnel Casualty Reports (PCR) using DCIPS became the Navy standard for reporting ALL personnel casualties and can be accessed at one of the below links:

2. New <u>PCR User Guide (April 2022)</u>. Need CAC Card to access reporting tool (DCIPS). If you are a privileged user and require assistance, please contact POC listed below.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- While a dependent death is not a full CACO case, in the Casualty Report's Remarks section a Command POC may be added in case FSGLI office needs to reach back to the command to discuss the needed substantiating documents from the sponsor and claim forms.
- 2. Once the PCR is submitted call the FSGLI office to make sure the message was received.
