The Tragedy Assistance Program for Survivors (TAPS) is the national organization providing compassionate care for the families of America's fallen military heroes and has offered support to more than 100,000 surviving family members of our fallen military and their caregivers since 1994. TAPS provides peer-based emotional support, grief and trauma resources, grief seminars and retreats for adults, Good Grief Camps for children, case work assistance, connections to community-based care, online and in-person support groups and a 24/7 resource and information helpline for all who have been affected by a death in the Armed Forces. The organization currently operates on an annual budget of approximately \$13 million. TAPS receives no government funds, and the organization's services are free of charge to the surviving family members they serve. TAPS relies on the generosity of donors to provide ongoing support for our programs.
