

THE VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

1. Using Edge, Chrome, Firefox or Safari, please cut and paste the link below, item7, into the address bar.
2. On a government computer, when prompted, select the BROWSER option.
3. On a home computer, you *may* install Adobe Connect, but you can open the site in the browser.
4. When you see the iCACO portal (blue wave/pic enclosed), enter your RANK and LAST NAME in the GUEST box.
5. You will be asked to wait for me to provide access and let you in, your, if I don't recognize you, I may not let you in.
6. Please have the AUDIO turned ON, speakers' volume up.
7. Class Link <https://connect.apan.org/navyicaco/>
8. Make sure you do not have the <noclick> in front of the iCACO URL/LINK/ADDRESS.
