Dear Mr. Secretary Sir -

Since 1942, the Naval Academy Golf Association has managed the Naval Academy Golf Course in Annapolis on behalf of the Navy. I am very proud of the unwavering history of support that NAGA has provided to the Brigade of Midshipmen and the Naval Academy mission in this role. Countless hours of Physical Education classes as well as the Men's and Women's Varsity Golf teams have benefitted and succeeded through their access to the course, equipment, locker rooms and coaches who are at their disposal. Last year, the women's team claimed the Patriot's League Women's Golf Championship and competed at the NCAA Championship Tournament.

In addition to the support that NAGA provides directly to USNA, we are the Navy's premier golf course in the region and provide the retired and active duty community opportunities for access and membership. In 2020 and 2021, we rebuilt the entire course with new fairways, re-designed greens, and a state-of-the art putting facility. We are planning a new clubhouse venue to provide the Members and the Naval Academy with improved user facilities including dining at the course.

We want to continue to grow on our service accommodations and we have started to explore options to construct a new golf course on the land known as Greenbury Point at the Naval Support Activity Annapolis. Our vision includes mitigation efforts that would include a walking trail for the community, a berm to fully protect some environmentally sensitive hazardous material on the land, address issues regarding the Navy's existing firing range, and mitigation of the loss of trees and conservation area. We intend to design the course in the most environmentally sensitive way possible while meeting the expectations of our partners at CNIC, NAVFAC and the local community.

I am asking for your support of this project by directing a sole source negotiated lease agreement with NAGA to develop and use the Greenbury Point land for this new golf course. The benefits of our partnership that NAGA has provided to the Navy and to the Naval Academy for over 50 years have demonstrated that it is in the best interests of the Government to enter into a sole source lease for this project. This will permit us to start the lease negotiations and to start the design process with a clear way forward and a more compressed timeline.





As per our telephone conversation a few moments ago, here is what I discussed with the Washington Post reporter

- 1) The land is owned by the Navy and there is no authority to proceed with any development, on any front, until the Navy decides that we may have the opportunity to create a vision. If the Navy doesn't approve, the concept is over.
- 2) There has been no formal concept development nor has a feasibility study been created. The project is purely on a conceptual basis.
- 3) Typical of development on any front there would be community involvement in the process along with all environmental agencies including oversight by the Navy.
- 4) Even if the project were to move forward, we would need to raise 35-40 million dollars to meet not only new development but mitigate current environmental concerns. Included in the private fundraising effort would be funds to enhance the property in a manner that would address the interest of the community and others that would use the area.
- 5) If we work through all the above then comes the challenge of creating a comprehensive recreational facility that would include walking and jogging trails, access to the Chesapeake for boaters, bird watching facilities, exercise stations and at least five miles of walking and jogging trails.
- 6) If created there is the responsibility to consistently address environmental requirements as dictated by the various governing agencies.
- 7) There are a number of fully compliant recreational and golf facilities currently on the Chesapeake Bay and each has taken the necessary steps to ensure compliance on all fronts.

The reporter's name was (6) (6) and and he seemed open minded and had no vested interest in the matter which led me to believe he would write a balanced story. Keep in mind I mentioned a number of times that if the Navy decides they would rather not pursue a feasibility study addressing the site then all of this goes away.

The short answer:

The Secretary of the Navy will utilize 10 U.S. Code § 2667 - Leases: non-excess property of military departments and Defense Agencies for an Outlease to NAGA. Policy is derived from this section, as well as from our SECNAV Instruction (11011.47D).

Short summary below, and full authority attached for your reference.

The following conditions apply to the outgranting of DON property:

- (1) DON real property may only be made available for compatible non-naval uses when it can be clearly demonstrated that:
 - (a) It is not excess property
- (b) Its use by others will not interfere with or adversely affect the accomplishment of the installation's mission, or with the DoD's present, planned or foreseeable use of the property, or with other Departmental activities in the vicinity; and
 - (c) The use will be at minimal expense to DON.
- (2) The user of DON real property shall be required to use, maintain, protect, and preserve it in accordance with sound management practices and the terms of the outgrant.
- (3) shall assume liability for loss of or damage to the real property and for third party bodily injury and property damage. User will be required to demonstrate to the satisfaction of DON sufficient financial responsibility to assume these liabilities, or, at the user's own expense, to procure and maintain sufficient insurance to cover them in certain minimum amounts, which requirements shall be identified in the real estate agreement.
- (4) Unutilized or underutilized property proposed for non-Federal use shall be reported by COMNAVFACENGCOM to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- (5) Prior to making property available to other users outside of DON, CNO will prepare an ECP document in accordance with reference (ay) that analyzes the environmental condition of the property and determines its suitability for the proposed use.
- Fair Market Value (FMV): lessees shall be required to pay consideration in cash or in-kind in an amount that is not less than the FMV of the leasehold interest, as determined by COMNAVFACENGCOM (Navfac Appraisal). In determining FMV, COMNAVFACENGCOM shall establish a monetary value of both the leasehold estate and the consideration to be received.
- Consideration and Reimbursement of DON Expenses: all non-DON users of DON real property shall be required to compensate DON for administrative expenses incurred, or to be incurred, by entering into the transaction. These expenses shall include, but are not limited to, the costs of surveys, environmental studies, appraisals, and the time of DON personnel, both at the installation and the contracting office. The funds received must be credited to the appropriate appropriation / fund. Any amount in excess of actual expenses will be returned.



10 U.S. Code § 2667. Leases: non-excess property of military departments and Defense Agencies

- (a) Lease Authority.—Whenever the <u>Secretary concerned</u> considers it advantageous to the United States, the <u>Secretary concerned</u> may lease to such lessee and upon such terms as the <u>Secretary concerned</u> considers will promote the national defense or to be in the public interest, real or personal property that—
 - (1) is under the control of the Secretary concerned;
 - (2) is not for the time needed for public use; and
 - (3) is not excess property, as defined by section 102 of title 40.

(b) Conditions on Leases.—A lease under subsection (a)—

- (1) may not be for more than five years, unless the <u>Secretary concerned</u> determines that a lease for a longer period will promote the national defense or be in the public interest;
- (2) may give the lessee the first right to buy the property if the lease is revoked to allow the United States to sell the property under any other provision of law;
- (3) shall permit the Secretary to revoke the lease at any time, unless he determines that the omission of such a provision will promote the national defense or be in the public interest;
- (4) shall provide for the payment (in cash or in kind) by the lessee of consideration in an amount that is not less than the fair market value of the lease interest, as determined by the Secretary;
- (5) may provide, notwithstanding <u>section 1302 of title 40</u> or any other provision of law, for the alteration, repair, or improvement, by the lessee, of the property leased as the payment of part or all of the consideration for the lease;
- (6) except as otherwise provided in subsection (d), shall require the lessee to provide the covered entities specified in paragraph (1) of that subsection the right to establish and operate a <u>community support facility</u> or provide <u>community support services</u>, or seek equitable compensation for morale, welfare, and recreation programs of the Department of Defense in lieu of the operation of such a facility or the provision of such services, if the Secretary determines that the lessee will provide merchandise or services in direct competition with covered entities through the lease;
- (7) may not provide for a leaseback by the <u>Secretary concerned</u> with an annual payment in excess of \$500,000, or otherwise commit the <u>Secretary concerned</u> or the Department of Defense to annual payments in excess of such amount; and
- (8) shall provide that any facilities constructed on the property may be constructed using commercial standards in a manner that provides force protection safeguards appropriate to the activities conducted in, and the location of, such facilities.

(c) Types of In-Kind Consideration.—

- (1) In addition to any in-kind consideration accepted under subsection (b)(5), in-kind consideration accepted with respect to a lease under this section may include the following:
 - (A) Maintenance, protection, alteration, repair, improvement, or restoration (including environmental restoration) of property or facilities under the control of the Secretary concerned.
 - (B) <u>Construction</u> of new facilities for the <u>Secretary concerned</u>.
 - (C) Provision of facilities for use by the Secretary concerned.
 - (D) Provision or payment of utility services for the <u>Secretary concerned</u>, which shall prioritize energy resilience in the event of commercial grid outages.
 - (E) Provision of real property maintenance services for the Secretary concerned.

- (F) Provision of such other services relating to activities that will occur on the leased property as the Secretary concerned considers appropriate.
- (2) In-kind consideration under paragraph (1) may be accepted at any property or facilities under the control of the <u>Secretary concerned</u> that are selected for that purpose by the <u>Secretary concerned</u>.
- (3) Sections <u>2662</u> and <u>2802</u> of this title shall not apply to any new facilities whose <u>construction</u> is accepted as inkind consideration under this subsection.

(d) Community Support Facilities and Community Support Services Under Lease; Waiver.—

- (1) In this subsection and subsection (b)(6), the term "covered entity" means each of the following:
 - (A) The Army and Air Force Exchange Service.
 - (B) The Navy Exchange Service Command.
 - (C) The Marine Corps exchanges.
 - (D) The Defense Commissary Agency.
- (E) The revenue-generating nonappropriated fund activities of the Department of Defense conducted for the morale, welfare, and recreation of members of the armed forces.
- (2) The Secretary concerned may waive the requirement in subsection (b)(6) with respect to a lease if—
 - (A) the lease is entered into under subsection (g); or
 - (B) the Secretary determines that the waiver is in the best interests of the Government.
- (3) The <u>Secretary concerned</u> shall submit, in an electronic medium pursuant to <u>section 480 of this title</u>, to the congressional defense committees a notice of each waiver under paragraph (2), including the reasons for the waiver.
- (4) The covered entities shall exercise the right provided in subsection (b)(6) with respect to a lease, if at all, not later than 90 days after receiving notice from the <u>Secretary concerned</u> regarding the opportunity to exercise such right with respect to the lease. The Secretary may, at the discretion of the Secretary, extend the period under this paragraph for the exercise of the right with respect to a lease for such additional period as the Secretary considers appropriate.
- (5) The Secretary of Defense shall prescribe in regulations uniform procedures and criteria for the evaluation of proposals for enhanced use leases involving the operation of community support facilities or the provision of <u>community support services</u> by either a lessee under this section or a <u>covered entity</u>.

(e)Deposit and Use of Proceeds.—

- (1) (A)The <u>Secretary concerned</u> shall deposit in a special account in the Treasury established for that Secretary the following:
 - (i) All money rentals received pursuant to leases entered into by that Secretary under this section.
 - (ii) All proceeds received pursuant to the granting of easements by that Secretary under <u>section</u> 2668 of this title.
 - (iii) All proceeds received by that Secretary from authorizing the temporary use of other property under the control of that Secretary.
 - (B)Subparagraph (A) does not apply to the following proceeds:
 - (i) Amounts paid for utilities and services furnished lessees by the <u>Secretary concerned</u> pursuant to leases entered into under this section.
 - (ii) Money rentals referred to in paragraph (3), (4), or (5).

- (C) Subject to subparagraphs (D) and (E), the proceeds deposited in the special account established for the <u>Secretary concerned</u> shall be available to the Secretary, in such amounts as provided in appropriation Acts, for the following:
 - (i) Maintenance, protection, alteration, repair, improvement, or restoration (including environmental restoration) of property or facilities.
 - (ii) Construction or acquisition of new facilities.
 - (iii) Lease of facilities.
 - (iv) Payment of utility services.
 - (v) Real property maintenance services.
 - (vi) <u>Administrative expenses</u> incurred by the <u>Secretary concerned</u> under this section and for easements under section 2668 of this title.
- (D) At least 50 percent of the proceeds deposited in the special account established for the <u>Secretary</u> <u>concerned</u> shall be available for activities described in subparagraph (C) only at the <u>military installation</u> or Defense Agency location where the proceeds were derived.
- (E) If the proceeds deposited in the special account established for the <u>Secretary concerned</u> are derived from activities associated with a military museum, the proceeds shall be available for activities described in subparagraph (C) only at that museum.
- (2) Payments for utilities and services furnished lessees pursuant to leases entered into under this section shall be credited to the appropriation account or working capital fund from which the cost of furnishing the utilities and services was paid.
- (3) Money rentals received by the United States directly from a lease under this section for agricultural or grazing purposes of lands under the control of the <u>Secretary concerned</u> (other than lands acquired by the United States for flood control or navigation purposes or any related purpose, including the development of hydroelectric power) may be retained and spent by the <u>Secretary concerned</u> in such amounts as the Secretary considers necessary to cover the <u>administrative</u> <u>expenses</u> of leasing for such purposes and to cover the financing of multiple-land use management programs at any installation under the jurisdiction of the Secretary.
- (4) Money rentals received by the United States from a lease under subsection (g) at a <u>military installation</u> approved for closure or realignment under a base closure law shall be deposited into the Department of Defense Base Closure Account established under section 2906(a) of the <u>Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act of 1990</u> (part A of title XXIX of <u>Public Law 101–510</u>; 10 U.S.C. 2687 note).
- (f) Treatment of Lessee Interest in Property.—The interest of a lessee of property leased under this section may be taxed by State or local governments. A lease under this section shall provide that, if and to the extent that the leased property is later made taxable by State or local governments under an Act of Congress, the lease shall be renegotiated.

(g) Special Rules for Base Closure and Realignment Property.—

- (1) Notwithstanding subtitle I of title 40 and division C (except sections 3302, 3501(b), 3509, 3906, 4710, and 4711) of subtitle I of title 41 (to the extent those provisions are inconsistent with this subsection) or subsection (a)(2) of this section, pending the final disposition of real property and personal property located at a military installation to be closed or realigned under a base closure law, the <u>Secretary concerned</u> may lease the property to any individual or entity under this subsection if the Secretary determines that such a lease would facilitate State or local economic adjustment efforts.
- (2) Notwithstanding subsection (b)(4), the <u>Secretary concerned</u> may accept consideration in an amount that is less than the fair market value of the lease interest if the <u>Secretary concerned</u> determines that—

- (A) a public interest will be served as a result of the lease; and
- (B) the fair market value of the lease is (i) unobtainable, or (ii) not compatible with such public benefit.
- (3) Before entering into any lease under this subsection, the Secretary shall consult with the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency in order to determine whether the environmental condition of the property proposed for leasing is such that the lease of the property is advisable. The Secretary and the Administrator shall enter into a memorandum of understanding setting forth procedures for carrying out the determinations under this paragraph.
- (4) (A) Notwithstanding the <u>National Environmental Policy Act of 1969</u> (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.), the scope of any environmental impact analysis necessary to support an interim lease of property under this subsection shall be limited to the environmental consequences of activities authorized under the proposed lease and the cumulative impacts of other past, present, and reasonably foreseeable future actions during the period of the proposed lease.
 - (B) Interim leases entered into under this subsection shall be deemed not to prejudice the final disposal decision with respect to the property, even if final disposal of the property is delayed until completion of the term of the interim lease. An interim lease under this subsection shall not be entered into without prior consultation with the redevelopment authority concerned.
 - (C) Subparagraphs (A) and (B) shall not apply to an interim lease under this subsection if authorized activities under the lease would—
 - (i) significantly affect the quality of the human environment; or
 - (ii) irreversibly alter the environment in a way that would preclude any reasonable disposal alternative of the property concerned.

(h) Competitive Procedures for Selection of Certain Lessees; Exception.—

- (1) If a proposed lease under subsection (a) involves only personal property, the lease term exceeds one year, or the fair market value of the lease interest exceeds \$100,000, as determined by the <u>Secretary concerned</u>, the Secretary shall use competitive procedures to select the lessee.
 - (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply if the Secretary concerned determines that—
 - (A) a public interest will be served as a result of the lease; and
 - (B) the use of competitive procedures for the selection of certain lessees is unobtainable or not compatible with the public benefit served under subparagraph (A).
 - (3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to a renewal or extension of a lease by the Secretary of the Navy with a selected institution for operation of a ship within the University National Oceanographic Laboratory System if, under the lease, each of the following applies:
 - (A) Use of the ship is restricted to federally supported research programs and to non-Federal uses under specific conditions with approval by the Secretary of the Navy.
 - (B) Because of the anticipated value to the Navy of the oceanographic research and training that will result from the ship's operation, no monetary lease payments are required from the lessee under the initial lease or under any renewal or extension.
 - (C) The lessee is required to maintain the ship in a good state of repair, readiness, and efficient operating condition, conform to all applicable regulatory requirements, and assume full responsibility for the safety of the ship, its crew, and scientific personnel aboard.
 - (4) (A)Paragraph (1) does not apply to a renewal, extension, or succeeding lease by the <u>Secretary</u> <u>concerned</u> with a financial institution selected in accordance with the Department of Defense Financial

Management Regulation providing for the selection of financial institutions to operate on <u>military installations</u> if each of the following applies:

- (i) The on-base financial institution was selected before the date of the enactment of this paragraph or competitive procedures are used for the selection of any new financial institutions.
- (ii) A current and binding operating agreement is in place between the installation commander and the selected on-base financial institution.
- (B) The renewal, extension, or succeeding lease shall terminate upon the termination of the operating agreement described in subparagraph (A)(ii) associated with that lease.

(i) **Definitions**.—In this section:

- (1) The term "administrative expenses" means only those expenses related to assessing, negotiating, executing, and managing lease and easement transactions. The term does not include any Government personnel costs.
- (2) The term "community support facility" includes an ancillary supporting facility (as that term is defined in section 2871(1) of this title).
- (3) The term "community support services" includes revenue-generating food, recreational, lodging support services, and resale operations and other retail facilities and services intended to support a community.
 - (4) The term "military installation" has the meaning given such term in section 2687 of this title.
 - (5) The term "Secretary concerned" means—
 - (A) the Secretary of a military department, with respect to matters concerning that military department; and
 - (B) the Secretary of Defense, with respect to matters concerning the Defense Agencies.
- (j) Exclusion of Certain Lands. This section does not apply to oil, mineral, or phosphate lands.
- (k) Leases for Education. Notwithstanding subsection (b)(4), the <u>Secretary concerned</u> may accept consideration in an amount that is less than the fair market value of the lease, if the lease is to a local education agency or an elementary or secondary school (as those terms are defined in section 8101 of the <u>Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965</u> (20 <u>U.S.C. 7801</u>)).



The Navy is no longer considering competing proposals to lease Greenbury Point, one to build a new golf course, the other to turn the space into a public park, a spokesperson for the service said Monday.

"We received competing proposals from Anne Arundel County and the Naval Academy Golf Association for a sole source lease and management of Greenbury Point, which makes it no longer possible to consider either party's request," Naval District Washington Director of Public Affairs Ed Zeigler said in a statement. "NSA Annapolis is currently evaluating the status and future of Greenbury Point in support of the mission of both the installation and the U.S. Naval Academy."

The request to lease the land to build a second Naval Academy golf course was made in February by Chet Gladchuk, president of the Naval Academy Golf Association. Gladchuk said he wants to explore what is possible on Greenbury Point, not just for golfers but for boaters, hikers and nature-lovers. Multiple environmental organizations have raised concern about the proposal to build a golf course so close to the Severn River and the Chesapeake Bay, citing pollution concerns.

Last week, County Executive Steuart Pittman requested a long-term lease of the 240-acre Greenbury Point parcel for management by the county's Department of Recreation and Parks as a conservation area with public walking trails. In a letter to Capt. Homer R. Denius, commanding officer of Naval Support Activity Annapolis, Pittman cited the concerns about a second golf course, saying there is a need to protect the property. He promised to use county funding to manage the property and work with the Navy to accommodate all mission-critical activities there.

The Navy did not immediately have a response to Pittman's request last week, but on Monday said the second and competing Greenbury Point proposal has prompted them to end consideration of either. Denius decided Friday that they cannot provide the requested lease when there is a competing party interested in the property, according to Zeigler.





Navy considering new golf course at Greenbury Point, concerning environmentalists

The Navy is considering a proposal to build a second golf course north of the Severn River, at Greenbury Point, a prospect that concerns environmentalists and neighbors who want to preserve nature on the peninsula.

Naval Academy spokesperson Maddie Flayler said the Navy has received a proposal from the Naval Academy Golf Association to lease land on Naval Support Activity Annapolis at Greenbury Point to build a second Naval Academy golf course. The association, a nonprofit relative of the Naval Academy Athletic Association, operates the existing course, which is open to midshipmen, USNA staff and active and retired military members.

Chet Gladchuk, president of Naval Academy Golf Association, said a golf course is just one element, and a potential element at that, of the proposal the Naval Academy Golf Association submitted. Gladchuk also leads the Athletic Association. He said they don't have a plan, but reached out to the Navy to see what it would support at Greenbury Point.

"It could hypothetically include a golf course, anything is a possibility out there," Gladchuk said. "Whatever we would do out there would be accommodating in much greater degree to the neighborhood and the community than it would be today."

The existing 18-hole course was established in 1944. It underwent an extensive year-long \$7 million renovation in 2019, reopening on Aug. 6, 2020. The course now features modern irrigation systems, lengthened greens and additional bunkers.

Greenbury Point has a gun range that is used by the Naval Academy for training. The area also has hiking trails and a nature center, which are closed when the range is in use. For much of the 20th century the peninsula was used for Naval communications transmission and research, but all but three of the radio towers from that period were dismantled in 1999, according to a brochure on the NSA Annapolis Morale, Welfare and Recreation website, www.navymwrannapolis.com.

Gladchuk said the association is interested in studying a variety of options to improve recreational access at Greenbury Point, including improvements to walking trails and infrastructure to fight sealevel-rise, such as berms.

Environmental advocates immediately raised concerns about the concept of a golf course. The entirety of the Greenbury Point peninsula is a part of the critical area, the buffer between land and rivers and the Chesapeake Bay.

Severn River Association Director Jesse Iliff said his organization will be closely watching the situation.

"The maintenance needs of a golf course in terms of their fertilizer and pesticides is very intensive land use that could have significant detrimental impacts on the river," he said.

Director of Public Affairs for Naval District Washington Ed Zeigler said Naval Support Activity Annapolis reviewed a proposal for a new course at Greenbury Point and forwarded it to Naval Facilities Engineering Systems Command Washington for additional review. Washington requested additional information, which NSA Annapolis is providing, Zeigler said.

He said eventually the proposal will make its way to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Navy for Energy, Installations and Environment for consideration. If the proposal is received positively, Zeigler said such a project would be subject to the National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA), and the Navy would also have to consider compliance with the Sikes Act, which protects natural resources on military installations.

The NEPA process would include public input and an opportunity for public comment, he said in an email.

The Sikes Act requires an installation, in this case NSA Annapolis, to make and follow an Integrated Natural Resources Management Plan. A copy of the most recent plan for NSA Annapolis was not available Tuesday, but Zeigler said the Navy is working to post the document online

A meeting with neighbors was planned for Tuesday evening, but was canceled after there was some anxiety over the proposal, Gladchuk said.

"We decided to pause and regroup," he said.

Chesapeake Conservancy President and CEO Joel Dunn said he has been underwhelmed by the transparency surrounding the proposal, which is being made for federal land owned by the Navy.

"Given the Biden Administration's 'America the Beautiful' plan, an effort to protect 30% of the land and water in the United States, and the Department of Defense's exemplary leadership within the Chesapeake Bay Program, it would be ironic if the Naval Academy Golf Association's proposal to lease the land ultimately reduced wildlife habitat and public access to the shoreline in Anne Arundel County," he said in a statement.





Bluf: In response to several Staffers from the MD Congressional Delegation inquiring with questions regarding the Sole Source request From the Naval Academy Golf Association (NAGA) for Greenbury Point Navy OLA and CNIC OLA are setting up a briefing (No date set) from me to discuss the Sole Source Process. Discussion:

I started the meeting verbalizing to all that my presence was neither endorsement or nonendorsement from the Navy of the NAGA proposal and the proposal was still being reviewed. I explained there were several reviews of the proposal before it reached the DASN, El&E level for final decision and there was no specific timeline required by the process that needed to be met. Chet Gladchuk then spoke and discussed in general terms the NAGA vision for Greenbury Point if the proposal was accepted. He explained the proposal included a golf course but also that improvements could be made to Greenbury Point. He discussed in general terms the threat of Sea Level Rise on the point, environmental issues currently on the point, and the need for more trails and access and how he could help address these concerns and others. Both Executive Pittman and

Senator Elfreth discussed their apprehension about the public concerns voiced so far regarding the proposal. After listening to Mr. Gladchuk, Senator Elfreth was interested in hosting a meeting with some of the environmental organization leadership who had concerns. Executive Pittman agreed that some exposure to Mr. Gladchuk's general idea could be helpful to reduce public anxiety for the proposal. Since 1942, the Naval Academy Golf Association has managed the Naval Academy Golf Course in Annapolis on behalf of the Navy. I am very proud of the unwavering history of support that NAGA has provided to the Brigade of Midshipmen and the Naval Academy mission in this role. Countless hours of Physical Education classes as well as the Men's and Women's Varsity Golf teams have benefitted and succeeded through their access to the course, equipment, locker rooms and coaches who are at their disposal. Last year, the women's team claimed the Patriot's League Women's Golf Championship and competed at the NCAA Championship Tournament.

In addition to the support that NAGA provides directly to USNA, we are the Navy's premier golf course in the region and provide the retired and active duty community opportunities for access and membership. In 2020 and 2021, we rebuilt the entire course with new fairways, re-designed greens, and a state-of-the art putting facility. We are planning a new clubhouse venue to provide the Members and the Naval Academy with improved user facilities including dining at the course.

We want to continue to grow on our service accommodations and we have started to explore options to construct a new golf course on the land known as Greenbury Point at the Naval Support Activity Annapolis. I am writing as a freelance journalist in Annapolis, MD, to discuss the tentatively proposed Navy Golf Club expansion at Greenbury Point. As you are aware, the proposal has not been presented but merely broached so far. However, it has alarmed a number of conservation groups and ordinary joggers, fishers and bird-watchers in the greater Annapolis community.

In reading the background articles, it appears that the Naval Academy Golf Association hopes to lease part or all of the adjacent land to its current course in order to expand and/or build a second golf course. This project has been described as "only a concept" but also as a "proposal" that is currently before the Naval Support Activity Annapolis.

I am wondering if you could clarify the following:

- 1) What exactly is before NSA Annapolis? An email? A proposed lease? A draft of a site plan? Something else? A concept is not usually in written format, so the answers have been confusing.
- 2) Who exactly is conducting the lease negotiations and planning? (b) (6) , the president of the Naval Academy Golf Association? The association's board?
- 3) Who is doing the planning? A design firm? A national golf course developer? A local golf course developer?
- 4) Why is a spokeswoman from the Naval Academy commenting on receiving a proposal? Did the academy itself receive such a proposal? I'm under the impression that the land is not technically owned by the Naval Academy. I thought it was owned by the Navy and under the governance of the Naval Support Activity Annapolis.
- 5) What exactly is the Naval Support Activity Annapolis? Who is in charge? Is there an office? A board?
- 6 Did the Naval Academy use Greenbury Point as an environmental mitigation area while renovating the Brigade Sports Complex and commissary? And did the Naval Academy Golf Association use that area while removing trees -- supposedly as many as 500?! -- for the \$7 million golf course renovation that was completed in 2020?
- 7) When did the Navy receive said letter from Naval Academy Golf Association? And you said today it's before the Navy Secretary. Some news articles suggest it is instead on the desk of Meredith A. Berger, Assistant Navy Secretary for Energy, Installation and Environment?

I'm happy to discuss this further by phone if you prefer. In addition, I will be sending a FOIA in order to determine what documents currently exist.





Greenbury Point Article in Capital Gazzette 16 Jan



Here is the article that generated a lot of traffic to Greenbury this weekend.

You can see them from just about anywhere around Annapolis: the three Eiffel-shaped towers on the far side of the Severn River. As ubiquitous as they are, they have an astonishing story to tell. A while back, I explored the head of the Severn River with my friend Tom Guay, who serves as the executive director of the Severn River Association, so it seemed right that we should check out the other end of the river together. Just this past week, we hiked some of the trails at Greenbury Point that wander around the base of those towers.

We met at the nature center on Bullard Boulevard, just past the Naval Academy golf course. Tom's family dog, Mahki, joined us on that chilly, overcast day. She's a fairly spry 11-year-old rescue mix of retriever and Australian shepherd "with a tiny dash of chow mixed in," Tom said. Dogs are permitted as long as their human is at the other end of a leash. Mahki gave me an introductory sniff and we were off on the trail.

I always enjoy spending time with Tom. We talk about history and books, music, birds and more history. As we rambled around the 231-acre peninsula, we wondered what it must have been like when the first English settlers showed up here in 1649 and established a gathering of tobacco plantations they would call "Providence."

Part of this peninsula was once owned by Col. Nicholas Greenberry (1627–1697), who became one of Gov. Francis Nicholson's commissioners of the new City of Annapolis in 1696. His tombstone was moved in 1925 to the St. Anne's churchyard, where you can see it today. How or why "Greenberry" became "Greenbury" was a piece of history that was a mystery to both of us. The trail took us along the banks of Carr's Creek that separates this part of the peninsula from the old North Severn Naval Station. The Naval Academy's firing range is on the far side of the creek, and when the Mids are using it, the trails on this side are closed to the public. You can log onto the Academy's Twitter account to check the current status.

The far side of the creek was also once the site of the first Naval Air Station. This is where naval aviation was born. In 1911, Lt. John Rogers flew the Navy's first biplane, a Wright Brothers B-1, fresh out of the crate from Dayton, Ohio, and assembled in the Academy's armory.

Over the next few years, pilots and mechanics tested early versions of floatplanes as well as the first catapult-launched plane that would eventually lead to modern aircraft carriers. An exceptionally nasty winter in 1917 compelled the Navy to move the air station to Pensacola, Florida, where it remains to this day.

We got off a muddy side-track and onto a wide, hard-packed gravel road. I've been asked by volunteers who tend to our local trails to remind readers to avoid using muddy paths. Churning up the mud makes an even bigger mess when the mud dries. There are plenty of paved or hard-packed trails to choose when it's been raining, and the volunteers work hard enough without having to deal with the mess left by inconsiderate hikers and bikers.

The road came out to the bank at the mouth of Carr's Creek with an astonishing vista of the Naval Academy, Annapolis and Eastport across the river. I told Tom about a chart I have dating from 1846 that shows the domes and spires of the city skyline from different angles of approach. That skyline hasn't changed all that much since that time, with the exception of the St. Mary's church steeple and the Academy chapel dome. In the foreground, we saw large rafts of diving ducks — pintails, canvasbacks, buffleheads and surf scoters.

At the end of the point, we had a panoramic view of the Bay, from Hackett's Point on the far side of the mouth of Whitehall Bay and the expanse of the Chesapeake Bay Bridge, all the way down to Thomas Point Light and Bay Ridge across the mouth of the Severn River.

This was Greenbury Point proper. Somewhere near here was the site of the first Greenbury Point lighthouse, built onshore in 1848. It proved to be not very useful since ships sailing from the northern bay couldn't distinguish the lighthouse light from the lights of the city in the background.

A screw-pile lighthouse, which looked very similar to the Thomas Point Light, was built a half-mile offshore in 1892. Like most of the other 42 screw-piles built around the Chesapeake Bay, this one succumbed to ice damage in 1918. The cottage was demolished in 1934, leaving the platform on its pilings. For the next seven decades, this structure was known by local sailors as "the spider buoy." It, too, was demolished around 2002 and replaced with the bundle of pilings we could see out there now.

The road took us underneath the outermost tower. Those towers have been part of the skyline since 1918, when the Navy built them as part of a huge high-powered, low-frequency radio antenna that allowed communication with France during World War I. America learned of the armistice that ended the "War to End All Wars" from here.



At the same time the Navy was developing advances in the field of aviation, it was also investing its vast resources in the new technology of radio communications, and that all happened right


here. These three towers are the remains of a complex of 19 towers that together formed one huge antenna capable of broadcasting radio waves to ships all around the globe. In the 1960s, the system was enhanced to the point where it could communicate with nuclear subs operating 65 feet below the surface anywhere in the world.

By 1994, satellites had made the radio-based system obsolete and the other towers were blasted down in 1999, leaving these three as landmarks. The Naval Academy Museum produced a fascinating video series called "The History of the Navy in 100 Objects." Dear Secretary Del Toro:

We write regarding the Greenbury Point Conservation Area that's owned by the United States Navy, and is currently being used by the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis for various activities.

There are a number of proposals being discussed or publicly mentioned as options for future uses of the Naval Support Activity Annapolis' substantial Greenbury Point property. As the federal representatives responsible for engaging most directly with the United States Navy on the future of this unique natural property, we wanted to outline three baseline requirements we have for the consideration of any proposal:

- The environmentally sensitive Chesapeake Bay, Severn River, and Carr Creek waters adjoining the property on three sides cannot be adversely impacted in any way.
- Public access to the property and its trails must be maintained at current levels, or preferably enhanced.
- Wetlands and all lands within the Critical Area must be maintained in compliance with the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Act and fully protected in perpetuity.

We urge you to carefully consider these requirements should you evaluate various proposals to redevelop or change Greenbury Point.




